Course Summary

★ Course Description

Students will learn the skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing in Korean.

★ **Class Participation:** When a student is observed not eagerly participating in class activities (talking in English, studying for other classes, taking a nap etc.), some points (1-10%) will be extracted from their final score. When doing something else other than instructed in the lab(internet surfing or e-mailing), you cannot get A or A- and the final grade will be lowered.

★ **Absences:** Points will be subtracted from your final score (0.5% per absence) for inexcusable absences and tardiness.

★ **Excusable Absences:** Absences can be excused in case of illness, family emergency, and other unforeseeable incidents beyond the control of a student. A signed note from a person who can verify the absence (e.g. a note from a doctor in case of illness) and his/her phone number are required.
